BASIC INFORMATION

The Kadyrov Chechen State University has an indefinite license for educational activities issued by the Federal Service for Supervision of Education and Science from July 23, 2021 № 2974 (License Renewal Order № 1025 from 23.07.2021), and also has a certificate of state accreditation issued by the Federal Service for Supervision of Education and Science № 1508 from 30.10.2015, № 2843 from 30.05.2018, № 3195 from 10.07.2019.



The structure of the University includes the following main educational units that provide training in educational programs of basic general education, secondary education, 22 directions of secondary vocational education, 39 directions of bachelor training, 24 directions of master training, 14 specialties, 15 residency programs and 15 programs of training of highly qualified personnel in the postgraduate program:

As part of the Kadyrov Chechen State University, there are also:

- preparatory department for foreign students;
- medical accreditation and simulation center;
- research and educational laboratories;
- museum;
- technology park;
- sports club;
- a number of scientific schools and a center of collective use;
- dormitories.

To train highly qualified personnel on the basis of the Kadyrov Chechen State

University the university has six dissertation councils to defend dissertations for the degree of Candidate of Sciences, for the degree of Doctor of Sciences.

The regional platform of the Agency for Strategic Initiatives "Boiling Point — Grozny" also operates on the basis of the university - a space for collective work, where students gather for discussions, problem solving, implementation of joint scientific and technical, innovative and socially-oriented projects.





HISTORY OF THE UNIVERSITY

The history of the Kadyrov Chechen State University begins on February 7, 1938, when the Chechen-Ingush Teachers' Institute with a two-year training period was opened on the basis of preparatory pedagogical courses. On September 1, 1938, the Chechen-Ingush Teachers' Institute was transformed into the Chechen-Ingush State Pedagogical Institute with a four-year training period. Personnel training at the Institute was carried out at three faculties: Philological, Historical and Faculty of Physics and Mathematics. A little later, the Faculty of Natural Geography was added to them. The first graduates of the young university were 79 people.

In 1940 there were 8 departments (Physics, Mathematics, Pedagogy and Psychology, Languages, Literature, Marxism and Leninism, General History, History of the USSR Peoples), 6 study rooms, auxiliary institutions: school hygiene, military training, gym,

physical laboratory, library.



Along with the solution of the main task, which was to train highly qualified teachers, the scientific methodological and work was started at the Institute's departments. A.I. Boyarchuk, T.T. Malsagova, F.G. Petrash, S.K. Shenets and other university teachers stood at its source.


The pre-war period was characterized by the organizational development of CHIGPI. Its structure was

improving and developing, its material base was becoming stronger, the number of the students was going up, and the scientific work was becoming more active. Research was carried out jointly with the Republican Research Institute of History, Sociology and Philology.

The Institute opened the faculty of pedagogics and methodology of elementary education in 1958, the faculty of natural geography in 1960, and the faculty of foreign languages in 1962. All faculties were training secondary school teachers in 19 specialties,

including teachers of native language literature. The formation of the Institute was accompanied by the continuous growth of the students. In 1956 there were a little more than 1000 students, in 1962 the number was 3218. The number of students increased to 4,750 in 1963.

1971. the Chechen-Ingush Pedagogical Institute was transformed into the L. N. Tolstoy Chechen-Ingush State University (ChISU), becoming the fifty-sixth university in the USSR.

The extensive and diverse relations of ChISU with enterprises and organizations of Chechen-Ingushetia, other republics, territories and regions of the country were coordinated by the research sector. A number of educational and scientific departments of the university had long-term cooperation agreements with the labor collectives of plants and factories. Contractual works in the interests of industrial enterprises of ChIASSR were carried out, including orders of defense industry enterprises.

Developing and strengthening its own base for research work, the University has actively influenced the formation of scientific personnel in various fields of economy, science and culture of the Republic. More than 300 specialists have received their academic degrees and titles since the university was established.

There are university graduates in every school, vocational school, and higher education institution in the Chechen Republic. They continue to train and educate the younger generation.

Since the day of its foundation the CHESU has been and remains the most important center of social and political life of the Republic, a forge for professionals with good professional knowledge, skills of organization and educational work.

Since the establishment of CHESU in 1971, new faculties and departments were opened, new academic buildings and student dormitories were built.

In the second half of the 1980s, such in-demand specialties as physical electronics, medical science, law, acting, journalism, and microbiology were opened.

In 1995, the university was re-named Chechen State University. Between 1994 and

2000, two military campaigns in Chechnya caused considerable damage to the State University. Its academic buildings, dormitories, libraries, botanical garden, unique research laboratories, teaching and production bases, computer center and printing house were turned into ruins. However, after resuming its activities in April 2000, the staff of the Chechen State University not only restored the pre-war level of the material base, but also reached new frontiers.

In 2021, the university was renamed the Kadyrov Chechen State University

MAIN ADVANTAGES OF THE UNIVERSITY

There are 81 universities in the North Caucasus Federal District, which educate 5.13% of the Russian student population. This is more than 214,000 bachelors', specialist and master's degree students, and more than 50% of this number are full-time students.

The Kadyrov Chechen State University - the only university in the region, which conducts multi-profile continuous training of specialists of all levels in 8 branches of sciences in the fields of engineering, mathematics, natural sciences, medicine, socio-economic and humanities. The range of implemented educational programs correlates with the priority areas of the subject's economic development identified in the Strategy for Socio-Economic Development of the Chechen Republic until 2030. Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education «Kadyrov Chechen State

University» is the leader in the North Caucasian Federal District on the scale of training specialists in mathematical and natural sciences and occupies ½ of the market share in this USSPA, in the sector "Agriculture and Agricultural Sciences". The University ranks 5th, its market segment is estimated at 10.43% in terms of student enrollment.

Thus, the Kadyrov Chechen State University is one of the leading and largest universities in the North Caucasian Federal District, where more than eighteen thousand



students study. The total number of employees of the University is more than 1200 people, including professors and lecturers - more than 700 people. **Special** attention should be paid to the dissertation council philological sciences opened in 2020. The Chechen Republic, as a bearer of rich ethno-cultural traditions, is of particular interest as a subject of scientific research. The Dissertation Council will contribute to the involvement of young scientists in the research of

problems of folklore, literary studies, bilingual artistic creation and journalism.

In order to increase the global academic competitiveness of the university, to create conditions for increasing academic mobility of students and faculty, to implement joint programs with foreign partners in 2020, international accreditation of educational programs in the field of medicine and information technology was carried out. Today the University is the first and the only higher education institution in the North Caucasus Federal District to receive international accreditation in medical specialties.

Currently, the University belongs to the category of classical universities, using multidisciplinary as a competitive advantage carries out scientific research in almost all areas of science.

With the support of the Russian Ministry of Science and Education, the University is in the preparatory phase of a project to create a carbon polygon in the Chechen Republic, train professional staff in environmental monitoring, and organize joint fundamental and applied scientific research in the field of environmental monitoring.

Taking into account the historical role and status of the University as one of the largest



educational, scientific and cultural centers of the North Caucasian Federal District, which plays an important role in solving priority economic, humanitarian and socially important

tasks of development of the Chechen Republic as well as the North Caucasian region, it was decided to participate in the competitive selection of the Russian Ministry of Education and Science for the status of participant of the "Priority - 2030" strategic academic leadership program. In this regard, a comprehensive program of the University development for the period up to 2030 is being developed, which provides for the development of educational, scientific and innovative activities, improvement of human resources, improving the quality of students, strengthening the integration of the University in the economy of the republic and the North Caucasus region. This program will be applied for the competitive selection for entering the all-Russian program "Priority - 2030" and getting the status of the National supporting university. Winning the competition will allow to attract additional funding for the implementation of a set of activities and priority projects, to improve the quality and demand for educational, scientific, technical, social and other services of the University to increase participation in the socio-economic development of the region, the development of human capital.

SCIENTIFIC, RESEARCH AND INNOVATION ACTIVITIES

Today, the Kadyrov Chechen State University is the center of attraction and employment of the highly intellectual elite. To train highly qualified personnel on the basis of Kadyrov Chechen State University the university opened six dissertation councils to defend theses for the degree of candidate of sciences, for the degree of doctor of sciences.

During the period of the university dissertation councils more than 80 defenses of candidate and doctoral dissertations took place.

The system of incentives provided in the university for the popularization of research activity and its effective functioning contributes to a significant increase in scientific publications in Russian and foreign highly ranked journals, activation of grant and inventive activity of scientific and pedagogical staff, as well as the involvement of



students, graduate students and young professionals of the university in science.

For the last three years the university became the owner of more than 80 patents for inventions and utility models, certificates for computer programs.

The Office of Research Work actively shapes and monitors the agenda of research activities.

It should be noted that the university publishes five periodicals indexed in the RSCI:

- 1. Scientific and analytical journal "Bulletin of Kadyrov Chechen State University".
 - 2. Scientific journal of the Faculty of Public Administration "FSU Science".

- 3. Scientific and practical journal "Bulletin of the Medical Institute".
- 4. Scientific and analytical journal "News of Kadyrov Chechen State University";
 - 5. Scientific and technical journal "Grozny Natural Science Bulletin"

Leading scientific schools of the university:

1. Biotechnology in the system of improvement and reproduction of agricultural crops and scientific justification of cultivation technologies of horticultural crops.

More than 280 scientific works are published in home and foreign scientific journals and collections, including 6 monographs, 5 manuals, 29 articles in peer-reviewed journals

and conferences Scopus and Web of Science, the author of 31 patents.

2. Sociolinguistic and linguacultural problems of general and Chechen linguistics.

89 research papers, textbooks and monographs are published.

3. A person in a Changing Socio-Cultural Reality.



More than 275 scientific and educational works and monographs have been published.

The university has a technopark - a structural unit created to support innovative



activities among students by forming material, technical, socio-cultural, service. financial and other base for the establishment, development, support of innovative start-ups. The University Technopark also organizes competitions and events, aimed at the development entrepreneurship, information technology and innovation in various fields.

The Technopark has the following divisions:

1. Laboratory of virtual and augmented reality;

- 2. Laboratory of neurotechnology;
- 3. Prototyping Center;
- 4. Robotics laboratory;
- 5. Space for collective work of the Agency for Strategic Initiatives "Boiling Point Grozny".

Technopark residents regularly participate in various events, contests and master classes.

The work with the residents is divided into 4 tracks:

- Track "Innovator" the most extensive track, which includes IT-specialists, programmers, engineers and software developers in various areas (virtual reality, augmented reality, neurotechnology, artificial intelligence, etc.);
- -"Designer" track work with projects and grant competitions, project and startup management;



- Track "Activist" coverage of Technopark activities, work with social networks, holding events;
- Track "Initiator" interaction with the Agency for Strategic Initiatives, work with the leader-id.ru portal, organization of events on the basis of Boiling Point;

Free courses. The Technopark has launched a series of free courses in current IT

trends. Among them:

- Working with the game engine Unreal Engine;
- Java Core programming language;
- 3D modeling;
- Video editing, working with Adobe Premier (StudOne Student Television);
- Frontend Web-development / mobile app development course.

Additional courses are expected in the near future and their further commercialization. Based on the results of these courses, it is planned to attract the best students to work on actual projects.

Ongoing projects:

- **Lelar** project passability analysis system using computer vision (grant winner of the "Umnik- 2020" contest).
- **VR-Gallery** project a virtual gallery with an opportunity to place the works of young artists;
- Project **Arego 360** a platform for viewing the main sights of the Chechen Republic using a virtual reality system.
 - Tactile response.
- **KORT** project optimization of public transport traffic using an artificial intelligence system (finalist of the "UMNIC Digital Russia" contest).
- -"ProLine Media School" is a social project aimed at highlighting the Technopark's activities and conducting master

classes in key media areas for residents and students. Winner of the MASHUK-2020 contest;

- **SocDis** project creation of interactive bracelets alerting people about social distance violation.
- **ARNOTE** project creation of products (notebooks, business cards) with augmented reality system.



- **UAV Laboratory** project creation of a laboratory for the assembly and maintenance of unmanned aerial vehicles.
 - Custom 3D printer mask printing project. Distinctive features:
 - Ability to print to individual parameters by 3D scanning a person's face;
 - printing of masks with individual design for each customer;
 - possibility of permanent use of the mask with the help of the filter change system

INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

The Department of International Cooperation, established and functioning since 2008, is engaged in the development and maintenance of external relations of the University. The Program of the Head and the Government of the Chechen Republic on training young specialists in leading foreign universities, which was carried out in the period from 2008 to 2013, played a crucial role in the implementation of international activity programs. To implement the program, agreements were signed with international educational centers in Germany and the United Kingdom (Study Group) (Great Britain), INTO (Great Britain) and DAAD (Germany), under which about 300 students of republican universities were



trained in the best educational institutions of Great Britain and Germany.

The university's activities in the educational arena are carried out both in the field of interaction with leading universities of the Russian Federation and with foreign educational institutions. Tangible results have been achieved in this direction. Currently, the university has more than 50 cooperation agreements with various universities and

enterprises. Among them are both Russian organizations and foreign ones – universities in Germany, Great Britain, Bulgaria, Kazakhstan, Spain, Yemen, Turkey and others, including cooperation with the German Academic Exchange Service DAAD, with the LOGO organization for conducting practical training for agricultural students.

In addition, the university is a member of the Eurasian Association of Universities and the Association of Russian-Azerbaijani Universities.

The international life of the university is also enriched by the participation of university delegations in many major events of the national and international level.

Internationalization at the Kadyrov Chechen State University occupies one of the key positions in the overall development strategy of the university. As part of the participation in the implementation of the federal project "Export of Education", the university directs its efforts to attract foreign students and teachers, as well as to create educational programs that are competitive on the world market. The activities of the



international activity sector of the university are aimed at ensuring integration into the international scientific and educational space, the development of international mobility of participants in the scientific and educational process. The Kadyrov Chechen State University makes every effort to create a comfortable environment for foreign citizens to stay in the region.

The number of foreign students at the university is about 200 people from 22 countries (Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Turkmenistan, Tajikistan, India, Ukraine, Egypt, Kyrgyzstan, Azerbaijan, Zimbabwe, Syria, the Republic of Korea, Nigeria, Iraq, Ghana, Pakistan, South Africa, Tanzania, Yemen, Sudan, Afghanistan) (as of April 2021).

All international students of the university are provided with a comfortable hostel for living on the university campus.



The range of educational programs that students choose is quite wide. The main interest is aroused by the programs of medicine (General Medicine, Dentistry, Pediatrics). the Faculty of Information Technologies (Software Engineering), Natural Sciences. **Economics** Management. The preparatory department annually graduates more than 50 people who studied under the pre-university training programs and at the courses of Russian as a

foreign language.

In 2019, the first enrollment was made for programs partially implemented in English. The teachers of the programs are both English-speaking university teachers, as well as those attracted from other countries and regions.

Graduates of the Scholarship Program of the Head and Government of the Chechen Republic for training young Personnel abroad, which operated from 2008 to 2013, are also involved in the implementation of programs in English. At the moment, more than 40 graduates of the Program are employed at the Kadyrov Chechen



State University in various positions.



The University holds summer and winter schools to promote Chechen culture for foreign students, where for two weeks guests get acquainted with the life, history, language, material monuments of the Chechen Republic, go on excursions to mountainous areas and local history museums.

- the area of educational support areas: 13.3 thousand sq. m.;
- the area of research units -3.3 thousand sq. m.;
- area utility room is 15.6 thousand sq. m. (one square points

catering – 5.3 thousand sq. m.)

- 3. The area of dormitories -12.2 thousand sq. m.
- 4. The area of other buildings and premises is 2.0 thousand sq. m.





All the buildings of the university and the dormitory are combined into a single local computer network with access to the Internet.

The university also has a student sports club, three gyms, as well as a GTO studio.

The university has two sports and recreation complexes "Swimming Pool", the studio "Run after me". There are sections for a variety of sports: basketball, football, volleyball, kettlebell lifting, chess, checkers,

freestyle wrestling, judo, wushu, grepling.

The university football team became the winner of the All-Russian football competitions among the teams of educational organizations of higher education "National Student

Football League".

Every year, students and staff have the opportunity to relax in the sports and recreation camp "Manas" on the coast of the Caspian Sea.











