Certification of Power of Attorney

Power of Attorney is issued on behalf of one or several persons in favor of one or several persons. It should contain the following information: place and date of its signing; name, surname, patronymic (full name of a legal body), residence address (location of a legal body) of a representing and represented person, their working positions (if necessary).

Certification of document's copy and its extracts

Consul certifies the authenticity of documents' copies and its extracts for legal bodies and private persons. Information in the documents should have legal status and must not be in conflict with the current legislation. The authenticity of a document's extracts can be certified only if the document contains several issues which are not related to each other (for example, extract from a service record).

Certification of signature's authenticity

Consul certifies signature's authenticity on the documents, which do not constitute a business deal. By certifying signature's authenticity Consul does not verify facts, indicated in a document

Certification of translation authenticity

Consul certifies authenticity of document's translation from one language into another.
